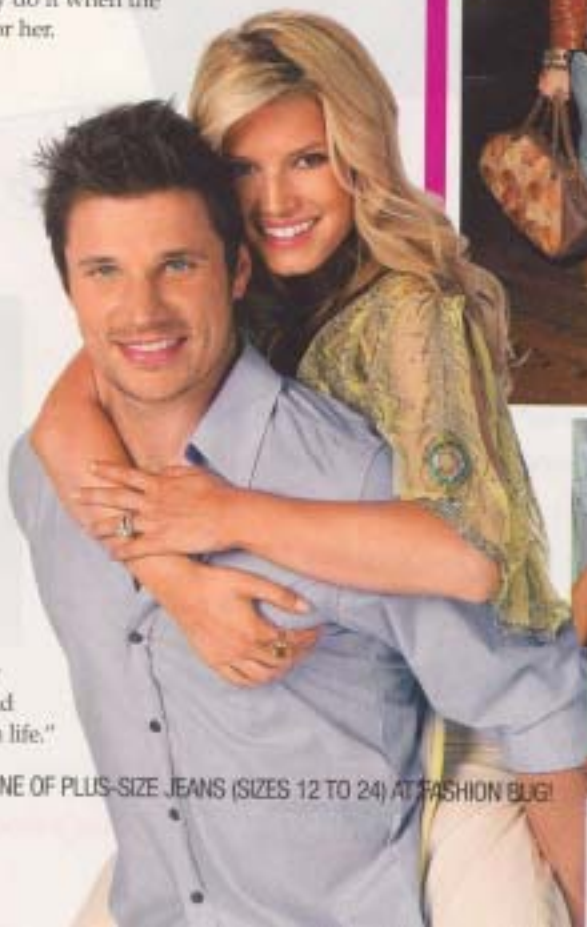
7 She knows what's right for her.
